Young Artist Gold Solo Competition

The Young Artist Gold Solo Competition is open to any flute player who is a member of SDFG and is under 29 years of age by the date of the festival. Persons wishing to participate in this competition may join SDFG upon entry and do not need to live within the Greater San Diego area. The festival's featured guest artist will be on the adjudication panel as well as qualified faculty from the San Diego area. Finalists will agree to perform at the festival at their own expense. The first prize is \$500, second \$250, and third place will receive \$100.

Information and Recording Guidelines

1. Recordings must be in CD format. Recordings **must** be unedited. Pieces should be recorded with accompaniment, whether with a live accompanist (preferred) or an accompaniment software program such as "Smart Music." Jewel Cases and CDs should not identify the name of the applicant.
2. All applicants must be a current (2010) member of The San Diego Flute Guild or enclose membership dues with application. Membership Application for the SDFG is available at www.sandiegofluteguild.org.
3. Repertoire for the Recorded and Final Rounds is (any edition is acceptable):
 - LeClair - Sonata in G Major, Op IX, No 7
 - I. Andante
 - II. Allegro ma non troppo
 - III. Aria
 - IV. Giga
 - Michael Colquhoun - Charanga
And Choose ONE of the following:
 - Liebermann - Sonata I. Lento con rubato and II. Presto energico
 - Boehm - Grand Polonaise
 - Jolivet - Chant de Linos
4. Contestants appearing in the Final Round may be accompanied by his/her own accompanist or may use a staff accompanist for an additional \$75.
5. All Judges' decisions are final. Finalists will be notified by email by March 26th, 2010.
6. Incomplete applications will NOT be judged or returned. Please check to be sure that all requirements have been met and are enclosed.
7. Two recordings, applicable fees and a written application (application available at www.sandiegofluteguild.org) must be postmarked by **March 15, 2010**. Applications with a later postmark date will be disqualified. All applicable fees must be included with the competition application. Mail recordings and application to:
