Chamber Music Festival

Sunday, May 31, 2009

Oak Valley Middle School

The Chamber Music Festival is for either groups of multiple flutes or mixed ensembles containing at least one flute player (example a woodwind quintet, flute and clarinet duet, 2 flutes and piano). Please, no flute solos with piano accompaniment. Multiple instrument ensembles are encouraged and you can have a multiple instrument ensemble (2 or more) with piano accompaniment. This is a great opportunity for students to play with their non-flute friends!

Festival Guidelines:

1. The SDFG Chamber Music Festival is open to all students through high school, as well as adult amateurs.
2. There will be no competitive divisions. Each ensemble's performance will be rated as "Good", "Excellent", "Superior" and/or "Command Performance" and the ensemble will also receive comments from the judges.
3. There is no limit to the number of ensembles a participant may register for.
4. Each ensemble must bring at least one ORIGINAL score of the music with numbered measures for the judges.
5. If an ensemble is awarded a Command Performance and more than one piece was performed at the festival, the judges will select the piece to be performed at the recital.
6. Participants are encouraged to pick a name for their ensemble. Be creative!
7. Ensembles receiving a Command Performance will be notified by phone and posted on the SDFG website.

Repertoire Guidelines:

Participants may perform any undirected piece for either multiple flutes or flute with another instrument. Music should be appropriate to the skill level of the participants. Keyboard or any other accompanying instrument is not permitted, unless it is in a Piano Ensemble. Remember: Solo Flute with piano accompaniment is not permitted at this festival. There is an 8 minute time limit.

Command Performance Recital:

The judges will select ensembles to perform in the Command Performance Recital at the end of the day at Oak Valley Middle School.

Fees and SDFG Membership Requirements:

1. Fees are \$10 per participant per ensemble or \$15 per participant non-member
2. All flutists must be a member of SDFG to participate. Other instruments do not have to be members.
3. Checks can be made payable to: San Diego Flute Guild
4. All performers in the ensemble must be students or amateurs
5. You can become a member or renew your membership by including a *New Membership/Renewal Form* with membership dues with the *Chamber Music Festival Registration Form*.
6. Entries must be *postmarked by Saturday, May 15, 2009*

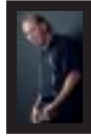

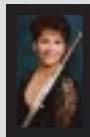

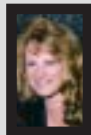
